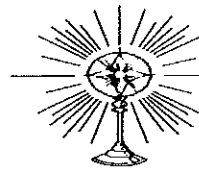

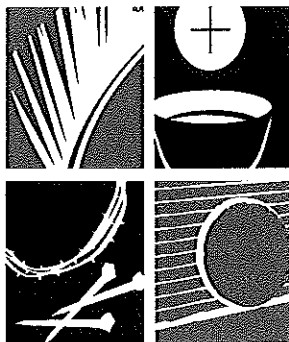

Each year during Lent, our Catholic parishes take up a special collection for the programs of Catholic Charities. Your donations will directly support essential programs including the Phoenix House Domestic Violence Shelter & Sexual Abuse Program located in Council Bluffs. This past year, 900 women and children received services at the Phoenix House and 97 women and 78 children received dignified shelter and care.
